## **GAUDENZIA'S SERVICES IN NORTH CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA:**

Gaudenzia operates 7 programs in the North Central area of Pennsylvania, providing a variety of services, including: residential women and children's programs, outpatient, and women and children's safe housing and support apartments.

Outpatient programs include:

- Pottsville Outpatient in Schuylkill County, serving 90 individuals.
- Middleburg Outpatient in Snyder County, serving 70 individuals.
- Sunbury Outpatient in Northumberland County, serving 180 individuals.
- Berwick Outpatient in Columbia County, serving 70 individuals.

Residential programs are based in Ashland, Schuylkill County and treat a total of 128 women and their young children. These include:

- Fountain Springs, a long-term residential program for pregnant and parenting women. Child Care is offered on-site at the facility.
- New Destiny, a halfway house for women and parenting women, provides safe and affordable housing as individuals transition back into the community through involvement in employment, education, and volunteer opportunities.
- Fountain Springs Apartments consist of six supportive housing units for homeless recovering women and children in Schuylkill County.

## **ABOUT GAUDENZIA:**

In 1968 in Philadelphia, a group of business, political, and community leaders, as well as people in recovery from drug and alcohol use, recognized a serious problem: a growing number of people affected by addiction were unable to find help. Gaudenzia was founded to help meet this need. Since then, it is estimated that Gaudenzia has admitted into treatment over 250,000 individuals.

Gaudenzia began as a single facility. Today we operate 161 programs at 90 facilities throughout Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware and Washington DC. Now serving about 17,500 individuals annually, Gaudenzia helps individuals and families affected by drug and alcohol dependency, mental illness and related conditions to achieve a better quality of life and become accountable individuals.
